## RULES & PROCEDURES

### Arrival & Check-In

Details and Directions will be sent via email before the event. You will receive your space assignment event wristbands at your arrival. You may set-up anytime between 8am - 8pm on Thursday & Friday. For special arrangements, please notify Doug Varnadore to make arrangements. All participants must be on the event grounds **No later than Saturday, September 5th**. ONE VEHICLE PER SPOT. Security will be provided from Thursday, September 3rd thru Monday morning, September 7th.

### Space Requirements

A 20x40 space is provided. Contestants must stay within their allotted space. Each contestant will receive one outlet with a 50 amp service and water from Thursday, Sept. 3rd thru Monday morning, May 7th. For power, you will need at least a 50 foot extension chord for hook-up. Also, this being a CHARITY event with sponsors, we ask that you keep any and all drink or food that you bring for yourselves, to remain inside your set-up.

### Vehicles

Participants will be allowed to park one vehicle with your rig / set-up. There will be a separate entrance/exit designated for contestants. No other motorized vehicles allowed (example, golf carts).

### Signage

In consideration of our sponsors, you may display one sign with a corporate logo, no larger than 2' x 5'. No restrictions on all other signage; however, the event reserves the right to make the final decision of what is acceptable concerning signage.

### Conduct

The Head Cook is responsible for the conduct of his/her team. We want all competitors to experience an awesome family atmosphere and make great memories at our event. Excessive alcohol use, use of controlled substances, foul or abusive language, excessive noise, failure to follow direction are all causes for disqualification and/or disciplinary action.

### Vending

All competitors that are vending must compete in all 4 categories of the competition. All food sales participants must sell **COCO-COLA** Products. Product will be available on the event grounds for you to purchase if needed. All vendors must complete a vendor form.

### Other

In addition to these rules and regulations listed above, the Kansas City Barbeque Society's Rules and Regulations will apply.
